Questions to consider, discuss or journal.

- 1. Have you ever considered leaving your church community? What factors impacted the decision you arrived at?
- 2. "There is a feeling in the air that people are leaving far more frequently than they ever have before." Do you identify with this observation? What do you think is at the root of this? Why do you think people are leaving the Christadelphian church?
- 3. What can your church community do to better understand the reasons people leave and learn how to help?
- 4. Have you experienced grief when losing a member of your community? How did your grief translate into action?
- 5. The Author shares 10 points to consider in your interactions with individuals on the edge of leaving. Have you taken these missteps? Which of her points most resonated with you? Which of these could you improve on?
- 6. What can your spiritual community do to create an environment where doubts and questions can be freely discussed in a safe and unthreatened manor?
- 7. What can you do to show that there is space in your community for people with questions and that even in a state of doubting there is belonging?
