Questions to consider, discuss or journal.

1. What questions about the Holy Spirit did you bring with you to this article? Did this article raise any new questions for you?
2. The Author shares that the theme of God's presence with his people through a special, sanctified angel, who is called the Holy Spirit is woven through out scripture, both the Old and New Testament. What does this theme reveal about God through all of scripture?
3. Have you considered the Holy Spirit as an Angel? The Author cites several examples: Philip and the eunuch, Isaiah, Exodus. Are there other examples in the Bible where we take the word spirit to mean either God's power or God himself, could we be missing references to angels themselves?
4. God often gives the assurance that "I will be with you." and the Author notes that this is done through the Angel of his presence. Have you experienced the Angel of God's presence before? Are there times in your life when you have felt God with you?
5. You will see that 'holy spirit' is power inside people, while 'the Holy Spirit' person is an outside influence representing God. What are the implications of this differentiation? Can you find other examples of this in scripture?
6. The Holy Spirit as an Angelic Being binds the whole Bible together in one consistent story – that of God being right here with us – his people – willing us on, helping, guiding and protecting us, being the caring, loving and compassionate God we know he is, always has been, and always will be. What does this teach us about God?
