Questions to consider, discuss or journal.

1. Do you feel a closeness with God? Do you see him involved in your day to day life?
2. Where do you look for God? Where do you find him? Where don't you find him?
3. How does God's involvement in your life affect your feelings of contentment?
4. Has there been a specific time in your life when you clearly saw God at work in your life? What were the details of this circumstance? Do you have a recent "God moment" you could share?
5. Seeing the hand of God working is a choice. What actions can you take to open your eyes to see him working in the your life and the world around you?
6. Are there situations in your life today that you could invite God into?
7. The author reminds us that every person we interact with could be 'one of the least of these, my brethren' and that the implication is that we are interacting with Jesus. How does this shift your perspective and change your actions?
8. Do you see God working in your spiritual community? As a group, what can you do to invite God into your congregation?
9. Pray to be helped by this discussion and that your eyes might be opened to to see God at work and find strength by his continual presence.
